#### III. CLOSED SESSION DISCUSSIONS:

- 1. <u>#001195095</u> Claimant was leaning on a desk when it collapsed, causing claimant to land on top of the desk. Total Incurred value: \$416,762.85.
- 2. #2019160223 While instructing in front of the board, student came from behind and inadvertently bumped into claimant, striking her right shoulder. Total Incurred Value: \$109,045.00.
- 3. #2019170152 While doing activities in gym class the claimant turned to pull a flag and heard/felt a pop in her right knee causing her to fall onto right knee. Total Incurred Value: \$97,462.45.

- 4. #2019156767 While mowing the grass the claimant slipped on a ravine and fell to the ground injuring his right elbow and right wrist. Total Incurred Value: \$81,354.29.
- 5. #001235333 Restrained by employees causing injury. Total Incurred Value: \$235,000.00.
- 6. #2017105464 Discrimination. Total Incurred Value: \$202,500.00.
- 7. #001107405 Claimant was walking out of copy room while carrying copies when she turned right and tripped over a garbage can. She landed with half of her torso on a chair and her right knee landing on the floor, injuring her back and knee. Total Incurred Value: \$81,779.47
