III. CLOSED SESSION DISCUSSIONS:

- #2018118306 While driving from the Middle School to School, claimant was involved in a motor vehicle accident. A trash truck was coming down the opposite side of the road and lost control, causing another vehicle to swerve and hit the claimant's vehicle. Total Incurred Value: \$105,428.00.
- 2. <u>#000825586</u> Claimant threw a large bag of trash into a dumpster and felt pain in his back. Total Incurred Value: \$281,661.00.
- 3. #2019155625 While turning out the lights in the cafeteria, the claimant lost her balance on the waxed floor and fell, hitting the left side of her face and injuring her right knee. Total Incurred Value: \$117,619.61.
- 4. <u>#2018131681</u> While lifting student onto toilet, claimant experience pain in left upper arm and shoulder. Total Incurred Value: \$107,750.68.
- 5. #2019147511 While moving furniture from one room to another, claimant strained her lower back. Total Incurred Value: \$86,601.03.
- 6. #2019153723 Due to a leak from the ceiling on the second floor, the claimant slipped and fell onto her buttock and right wrist. Total Incurred Value: \$80,616.79.
- 7. #001225728 Claimant was driving the school bus, when he was rear-ended by another vehicle. Mr. Wachter noted that the district could not accommodate work, as the individual was a bus driver. Total Incurred Value: \$47,551.11.
- 8. #2017089782 Emotional Distress. Total Incurred Value: \$210,000.00.
- 9. #0011241261 Fell from desk. Total Incurred Value: \$265,000.00.
- 10. <u>#2019152068</u> A coil in the HVAC unit froze and ruptured in the ceiling of the Art room. Total Incurred Value: \$59,500.00.
- 11. #2019151796 Mold was discovered as the result of a water leak from the metal roof capping. Total Incurred Value: \$34,500.00.
