- 1. <u>#2018120053</u> Claimant was on a ladder removing balls from the roof, when he fell off the ladder injuring his right foot. Total incurred value \$93,090.00.
- <u>#2018113331</u> Claimant was walking a 5 year old in front of her, with her hands under his arm, when the child stopped abruptly in front of her causing the claimant to injury her left Achilles tendon. Total Incurred value: \$90,103.00.

- 3. <u>#001226084</u> Alleges concussion, bruised kidney, back injury and head trauma from alleged assault on a school bus. Total Incurred value: \$80,000.00.
- 4. <u>#2018121992</u> A pipe froze and burst in the ceiling of the guidance office at the high school. Total Incurred value: \$29,500.00.
- 5. <u>#2017104615</u> Claimant was walking in the hallway when she slipped and fell on shredded carrots that were dropped on the floor. Total Incurred value: \$147,288.00.
- 6. <u>#001161317</u> The claimant was walking out of her classroom, when she tripped over a student's backpack and fell. Total Incurred value: \$130,795.00.
- 7. <u>#000852871</u> The claimant was mopping the auditorium floor, when she bumped her right knee against a chair. Total Incurred value: \$82,267.00.
- 8. <u>#2018124589</u> Claimant was in the classroom sitting on a rolling-chair when she fainted and struck her head on the floor. Total Incurred Value \$81,139.00.
- 9. <u>#2018114945</u> The claimant was cutting off the visor on a face mask of a football player, and cut finger with scissors. Total Incurred Value: \$66,433.38.
