III. CLOSED SESSION DISCUSSIONS:

- 1. #2018111453 While staff was participating in responsive classroom activity, claimant was moving from chair-to-chair, when she felt a sharp pop and pain on top of her left foot. Total Incurred Value: \$27,560.36
- 2. 2018121926 Harassment/Retaliation. Total Incurred Value: \$105,000.00.

- 3. <u>2019151827</u> While turning left to go up the 4th grade hallway, claimant pivoted and slipped on condensation on the floor; falling with her left leg going forward and weight shifting onto the left leg. Total Incurred Value: \$236,074.98.
- 4. <u>216075898</u> While putting away a ladder, the claimant stepped backwards onto the custodial cart, causing him to fall backwards. To stop his fall, he grabbed onto storage shelving in front of him injuring both shoulders. Total Incurred Value: \$233,613.00.
- 5. <u>2019156590</u> During a demonstrating during gym class, the claimant was walking backwards when she stepped wrong and fell, hitting her head on the gym floor. Total Incurred Value: \$145,942.04.
- 6. <u>2019154552</u> While trying to break up a fight between students, the claimant was punched in right upper arm and fell to the ground on her lower back and hip. Total Incurred Value: \$124,771.29.
- 7. <u>000821505</u> A special needs student pulled the claimant's right arm, causing the claimant to fall to the floor on her right side. Total Incurred Value: \$110,197.68.
- 8. <u>2019159128</u> Claimant was trying to restrain an aggressive student when he was kicked twice in the right knee. Total Incurred Value: \$86,281.02.
- 9. <u>2018112076</u> While walking to car for lunch, claimant fell in the parking lot. Total Incurred Value: \$48,952.02.
- 10. <u>2018119176</u> After a school meeting, claimant was walking down the steps when she tripped and fell injuring right arm, shoulder, back, hand, bilateral knees and bilateral ankles. Total Incurred Value: \$33,057.05.
- 11. <u>2018112159</u> While bending down to help one student in the playground, a 5 year old student ran into the claimant causing them to bump heads. Total Incurred Value: \$27,797.15.
- 12. 2017089782 Sexual Harassment/Discrimination. Total Incurred Value: \$210,000.00.
- 13. 001241261 Fell from desk. Total Incurred Value: \$2,565,000.00.
- 14. 001190018 Trip and fall same level. Total Incurred Value: \$350,000.00.
- 15. <u>001112073</u> While using a backpack leaf blower, the claimant coughed and heard right side of his low back pop. Total Incurred Value: \$20,605.30.
- 16. <u>20191625767</u> Claimant was demonstrating a basketball drill for the team, and she landed she heard 3 pops from her left knee. Total Incurred Value: \$95,879.75.
