III. CLOSED SESSION DISCUSSIONS:

1. <u>#001237633</u> – Claimant was walking down a hallway, when she tripped and fell onto her entire left side. She hit her head on the ground. Total Incurred value: \$167,778.00.

- <u>#2019177453</u> After the graduation ceremony, the claimant was picking up folding chairs and stacking them on a pallet and felt a strain in the right shoulder. Total Incurred Value: \$124,669.00.
- <u>#2019174377</u> While walking down the steps, the claimant's left foot became caught on the steps, causing him to lose his balance. He did not fall, but felt pain in his left knee. Total Incurred Value: \$57,711.00.
- 4. <u>#2016081606</u> Claimant suffered injuries as the result of injuries sustained in the weight room. Total Incurred Value: \$105,000.00.
- 5. <u>#2020181907</u> Lightning damage to various components at the Eastern Regional High School. Total Incurred Value: \$64,600.00.
- 6. <u>#2019177564</u> The claimant was painting in the library when she climbed the ladder and stepped onto the bookcase causing the bookcase to collapse and hit the claimant. She fell onto the floor and injured her left shoulder. Total Incurred Value: \$108,406.04.
- 7. <u>#2018145367</u> Claimant was sitting in the bus outside of the Franklin Institute during a field trip, when the bus was struck by a car. Total Incurred Value: \$27,312.93.
- 8. <u>#2018145339</u> Claimant was sitting in the bus outside of the Franklin Institute during a field trip, when the bus was struck by a car. Total Incurred Value: \$60,971.12.
- <u>#2019160522</u> The claimant went to stand up from kneeling and hit her head on the TV mounting bracket. She later began to feel nauseous and dizzy, and had a headache. Total Incurred Value: \$34,967.75.
- 10. <u>#2018130096</u> Claimant alleges violation civil rights. Total Incurred Value: \$185,000.00.
- 11. <u>#001227648</u> Claimant suffered injuries from ingesting color powder while bagging powder for run. Total Incurred Value: \$275,000.00.
- 12. <u>#2018111284</u> Claimant alleging discrimination. Total Incurred Value: \$300,000.00.
- <u>#2017092324</u> MVA Rear ended by Insured vehicle while at red light. Total Incurred Value: \$130,000.00.
- 14. <u>#2017105464</u> Claimants alleging discrimination. Total Incurred Value: \$155,000.00.
- 15. <u>#2020184598</u> The clean out cap for the cast iron pipes and sewer lines blew out causing sewage and water overflow. Total Incurred Value: \$32,025.00.
