- <u>#2018128775</u> While moving a large air compressor on a dolly, the compressor shifted weight and fell over landing on claimant's left foot. Total Incurred Value: \$65,123.50.
- 2. <u>#2016074551</u> Varsity Football Injury. Total Incurred value: \$60,000.00.
- 3. <u>#001238557</u> Alleged sexual molestation. Total Incurred value: \$220,000.00.

- 4. <u>#001226084</u> Caused by other party (Pushing/Assault by other students). Total Incurred value: \$105,000.00.
- 5. <u>#2018121926</u> Harassment/Retaliation. Total Incurred value: \$105,000.00.
- 6. <u>#2018130835</u> Claimant was emptying a heavy (60 lbs.) dust collector and barrel when he felt a "snap" near his left bicep. Total Incurred value: \$62,726.76.

- 9. <u>#2019152003</u> Claimant fell face-down while walking in the hallway. Total Incurred Value: \$120,510.00.
- 10. <u>#2018146349</u> While climbing off/out of back of work truck, claimant's leg gave out causing claimant to fall to ground twisting right knee. Total Incurred Value: \$106,302.15.
- 11. <u>#2018125135</u> Claimant was bent down attempting to get student up from floor when the student kicked the claimant on the right knee. Total Incurred Value \$95,028.87.
- 12. <u>#2018121712</u> During the day, claimant sustained multiple injuries due to incidents with students that were punching, kicking and hitting claimant in the right hand/wrist, right knee and left thigh. Total Incurred Value \$89,568.88.
- 13. <u>#2018123405</u> While bringing in cones, walking down hallway in Quarter A of school, the claimant passed out and woke up with left shoulder pain. Total Incurred Value \$84,579.23.
