- ALL PURCHASES MUST BE APPROVED BY IT
- PROPER HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE VETTING, FOR COMPATIBILITY AND RISK
- VIGILANT PATCHING
- INVESTMENT IN IT STAFF AND TRAINING
- EDUCATION OF STAFF, CYBER S.A.F.E PROGRAM



ROLE OF IT IN MANAGING RISK AT WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP & GETTING STARTED


- It's a marathon not a race and there is no finish line
- START SOMEWHERE, QUICK WINS THAT ARE HIGH IMPACT LIKE A RIGOROUS PATCHING SCHEDULE
- RISK THE INVESTMENT OF AN AUDIT, YOU DON'T KNOW WHAT
 YOU DON'T KNOW, THIS WILL CREATE A ROADMAP. IDEALLY
 SHOULD BE DONE SEMI-ANNUALLY
- TEAM APPROACH WITH PURCHASING: CURRICULUM->IT >BUSINESS OFFICE & ADMINISTRATION
- DELAY PURCHASES, IF POSSIBLE, UNTIL THE RIGHT INVESTMENT CAN BE FUNDED
