- <u>#2022250235</u> While in the guidance office, claimant's ankle "gave-out" causing her to fall onto the floor. Total Incurred Value: \$542,253.60.
- <u>#2022251406</u> While in classroom the claimant slipped and fell onto right hip. Total Incurred Value: \$223,631.00.
- <u>#2021221509</u> The claimant was putting a sander in the back of truck and twisted his body, straining his lower back. Total Incurred Value: \$204,539.43.
- <u>#2022247689</u> While carrying tables and chairs out of a trailer, the claimant stepped down and fell hitting his right shoulder and left thigh. Total Incurred Value \$138,831.48.
- <u>#2022243877</u> While restraining a special needs student the claimant felt a "pop" in his left shoulder. Total Incurred Value \$122,603.97.
- <u>#2022251241</u> While walking up the stairs the claimant fell forward and injured his forehead with a laceration above the left eye. Total Incurred Value \$65,062.25.
- 7. <u>#2021222966</u> Discrimination. Total Incurred Value \$135,000.00.
- <u>#2022246942</u> Storm Ida heavy rains damaged two classrooms of school. Total Incurred Value \$30,000.00.
