C. Student Accident Program

Ms. Colaianni discussed her report included in the agenda regarding the SPELL JIF Student Accident Program. She advised that Hartford Insurance, the carrier, has offered a two-year rate lock keeping the premium the same through 2023-24. She recommends accepting the rate lock since schools are now back in-person and there is the potential for student accidents to increase. She noted that the program is marketed every 3 years and due again for the 2023-24 fund year. If the rate lock is accepted, this will be postponed until 2024-25.

Executive Director/Underwriting Manager Summary

1. Underwriting and Finance Director

2022-2023 Renewal Negotiations/Proposal Presentation – MOTION REQUESTED Mr. Hoffman reviewed the 2022-2023 SPELL JIF Program Renewal Summary provided via email and also shared on screen, line by line coverage. He reviewed each item in detail. The program structure is the same with regard to limits.

Mr. Hoffman finished reviewing the overall coverage structure and budget for the 2022-2023 fund year and formally requested the SPELL JIF Board of Trustees to give their authority to bind the final coverages, subject to any pending items noted that require closing negotiation with the carriers.

Motion by Dr. Fox, second by Mr. Kaz, granting authority to bind coverage on the final reinsurance program. All in favor. Motion carried.

Mr. Hoffman advised that he also included the Gallagher Spring/Summer Insurance Market Report which provides insights into what continues to drive some of the market pressure we are seeing and where rates/coverages are expected to trend going forward. Also provided are the new forms for Travelers Boiler & Machinery coverage limitation and exclusions added to the Excess Liability layer of Pollution coverages involving PFAS (forever chemicals).

2022-2023 Certificate of Coverage – Mr. Hoffman stated that the final version of the Certificate of Coverage would be emailed to all districts once determination of all coverages has been made, coverages are bound and policy numbers provided.
