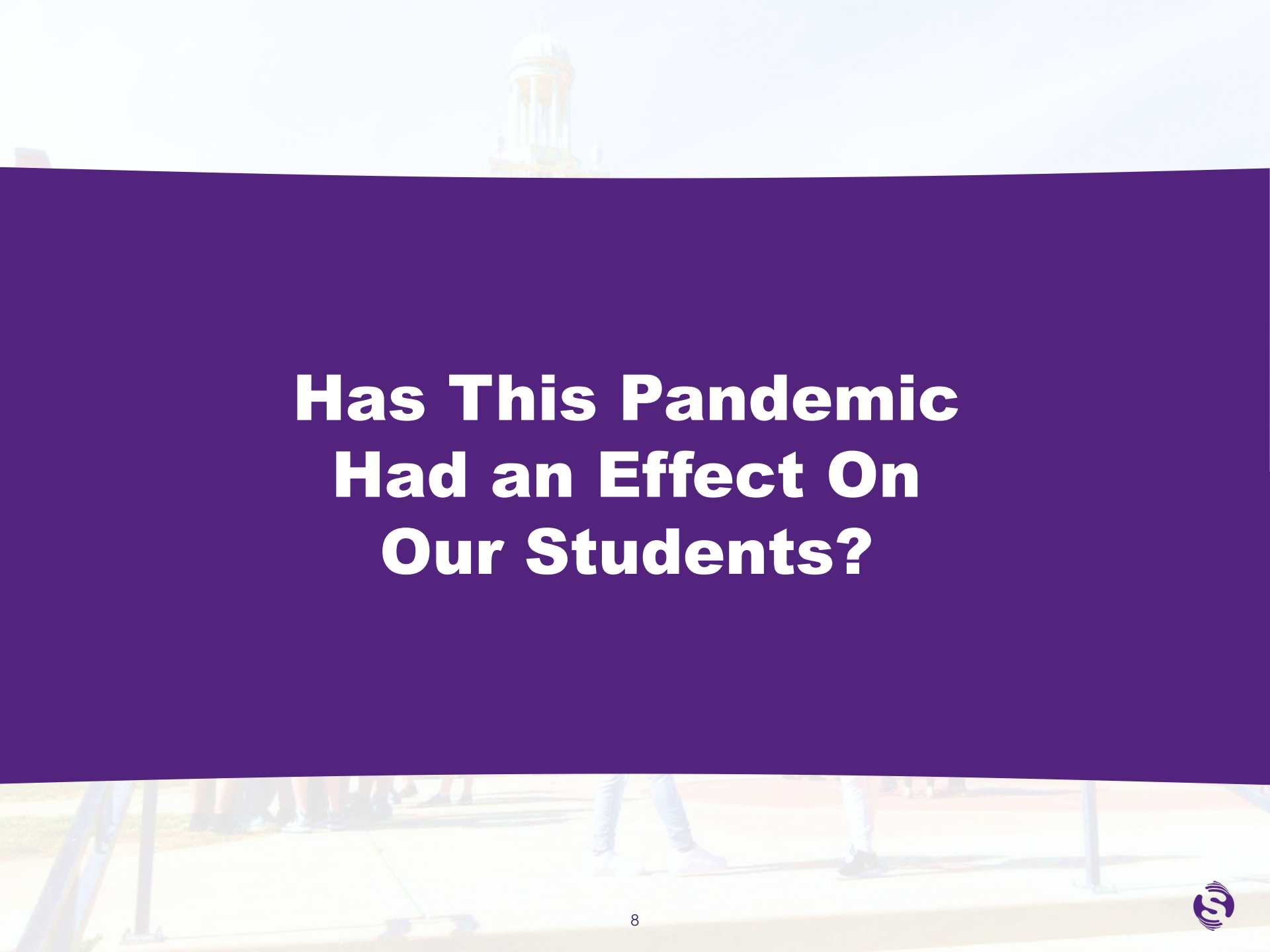

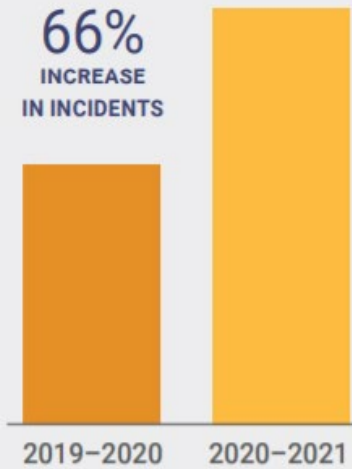

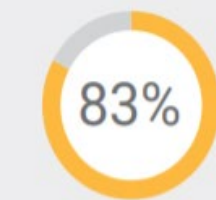

What Are We Seeing?

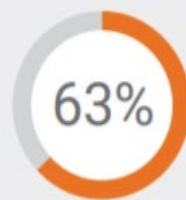
When comparing the first three months of the current school year with the same time frame from the 2019–20 school year, the results are astonishing. We've logged a **66% overall increase in incidents** since students returned for the 2020–21 school year.



The data paints a clear picture of struggling students, with noticeable increases across four of our incident categories:

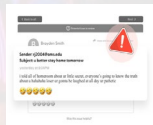

Step 1 Report an Incident

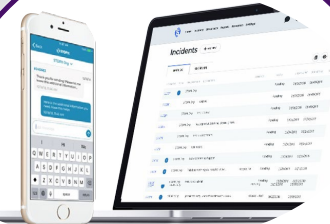
Step 2 Monitor & Notify



STOPit 24/7 Incident
Monitoring Center (IMC)

*Agents review, monitor, and
escalate the tip (as needed) if
it is life-threatening*

Step 3 Manage & Resolve



STOPit Admin Incident
Management System (IMS)

*School officials are alerted via text,
email and call (as needed) to review
and act upon the incident*

- **SEL, compliance, and mental health& wellness curriculum** for students, staff, and parents
- **LMS** can be used for assembly, classroom, and/or individual assignment to ensure the greatest use and impact – all programs tailored to grade levels
- **Training available live and virtual live** for an additional fee to base cost
- **Anonymous Reporting Training** for all users - from understanding the signs to actioning against tips

Anonymous Reporting System

- **Optional addition of Crisis Text Line** for students to seek help and assistance directly from trained experts / integrated in app only
- **Crisis Text Line** serves anyone, in any type of crisis, providing access to free, 24/7 support via a medium people already use and trust: text.
 - Connect with Counselor
 - Explain situation
 - Counselor moves individual from hot to cold place
 - Places help with expert volunteer
 - Safety measures in place for any life-threatening situations



NEW Feature Options ...

NEW Incident Management Center (IMC) Options

Out-of-Hours Coverage – IMC agents receive, vet and action against all life-threatening incidents during out-of-school hours (e.g. 6PM-6AM Daily)
