

Effects of the pandemic on teen mental health


Percent of parents noticing a new problem or worsening of an existing problem





What Are We Seeing?

When comparing the first three months of the current school year with the same time frame from the 2019–20 school year, the results are astonishing. We've logged a 66% overall increase in incidents since students returned for the 2020–21 school year.



The data paints a clear picture of struggling students, with noticeable increases across four of our incident categories:



Increase in Suicide & Self-Harm



Increase in Violence Toward Others



Increase in Nudity & Sexual Content



Increase in Drugs & Alcohol

Identify & Intervene

How Does It Work ...

Step 1 Report an Incident



Student reports an incident using 1 of the 3 optional methods

Step 2 Monitor & Notify



Agents review, monitor, and escalate the tip (as needed) if it is life-threatening

Step 3 Manage & Resolve



School officials are alerted via text, email and call (as needed) to review and act upon the incident

- Optional addition of Crisis Text Line for students to seek help and assistance directly from trained experts / integrated in app only
- Crisis Text Line serves anyone, in any type of crisis, providing access to free, 24/7 support via a medium people already use and trust: text.
 - Connect with Counselor
 - Explain situation
 - Counselor moves individual from hot to cold place
 - Places help with expert volunteer
 - Safety measures in place for any life-threatening situations

NEW Incident Management Center (IMC) Options

Out-of-Hours Coverage – IMC agents receive, vet and action against all life-threatening incidents during out-of-school hours (e.g. 6PM-6AM Daily)
